Dress Regulations	GNAS Rule 307 will apply
Drugs Testing	All archers will be liable for drugs testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or Guardians must authorise drugs testing of junior archers on the entry form.
Photographs	Anyone wishing to take photographs during the event must complete & SIGN the Photograph Log before doing so.
Refreshments	Hot food and drink can be purchased and the bar in the rugby club will also be open at lunch time. Tea, coffee & cakes will be available during the day.
Awards	Trophies and Medals will be awarded to all classes, including separate Ladies & Gents. Junior awards depending on entrance.
Team Awards	Team of 4 mixed: Team must include at least 1 lady and 1 gent and no more than 2 compound.
Liability	No responsibility will be accepted by Bath Archers for any loss, damage or injury no matter how caused – entry implies acceptance of these conditions.
Toilets	Toilets available in the Rugby Club plus 3 portaloos on field.
Music	Music may be played between scoring ends.

Discipline	The Director of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times. Their decision in all matters is final and must be obeyed. The Tournament Organiser has the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour.
Parking	All cars must be parked in the Rugby car park, please let the Tournament Organiser know if you have special requirements.
Tents	Competitors are permitted to set up tents on the competition field from strictly Friday 5:00pm onwards. Bath Archers accept no responsibility or liability for equipment or valuables left on the field unattended and recommend they be removed overnight.
Walkways	The cross hatched walkways from the waiting line to the back of the tent area must be kept clear at all times .
Targets	We will have 27 targets hired from Ten Zone Targets.
Junior Target Distances	All junior rounds will be Metric III with 4 spaces each. If full, you will automatically be put onto a waiting list and be notified.
Target Faces	For two longest distances, one 122cm face For two shortest distances, one 80cm face All faces will be 10 zone scoring for all bow types. 6 arrows in 4 minutes will be shot for the two longer distances, 3 arrows in 2 minutes will be shot for the two shorter distances
Camping	Camping will be available on the Avon Rugby Club grounds marked on the maps. Please contact Tournament Organiser for more details, cost of £3 per night per tent.

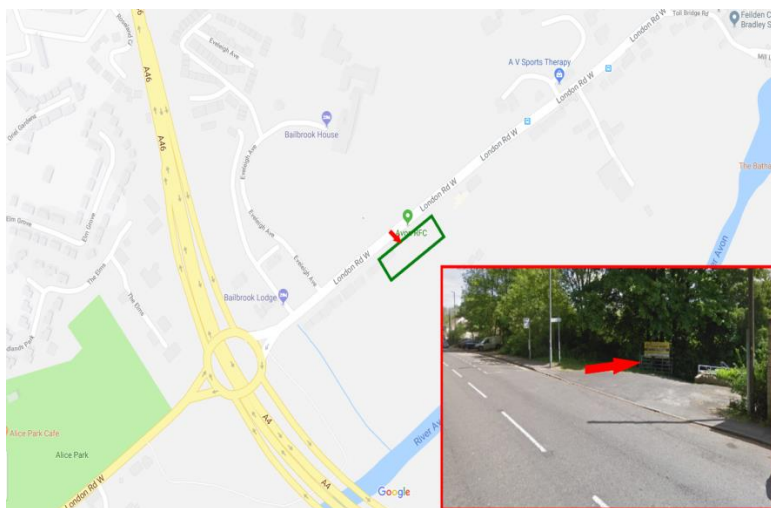
Bath Archers at Avon RFC

The RFC field is next to Bath Archers ground on London Rd West.

From M4 j18, follow A46 towards Bath. When you reach the large underpass on the dual carriageway, take the left turn towards Batheaston. Avon Rugby is on the right.

From the south, on the A36 follow the route through Bathampton, over the narrow canal bridge to the Toll Bridge over the river Avon (80p). Up the hill and turn left at the mini roundabout. Avon Rugby is on the left (this sign is harder to see from this direction).
