Report

Unlike last year, the field was dry and, whilst it was not sunny, the weather was OK; it remained dry, but the brisk Easterly wind was definitely from somewhere very cold!

Rather than sitting around twiddling my thumbs and eating bacon rolls, I took on the roles of field captain and tournament organiser again this year. As TO I was much assisted by Kathy who organised the prizes, catering, raffle and many of the other myriad things that go to putting on a successful tournament.

The field party were setting up from before 7:30, and by assembly the field was looking good and bacon rolls and coffee sales were well under way from our new double sized fold up gazebo. This proved its worth despite trying to escape when the wind got up!

We had 16 targets and 57 booked to shoot. Only 3 people could not make it on the day, so 54 took part - 9 ladies and 45 gents shooting a mix of longbows (18), barebows (7), recurve (17), and compound (12).

With assembly at 10:30 and last arrow at about 15:45, the shoot went smoothly with no major holdups (and no lost arrows!) and had a relaxed and friendly atmosphere – a great start to the season. Ends were shot without whistle-controlled details, and the feedback from the archers was that it had been a fun, enjoyable day - whilst not yet confirmed it appears that 2 County Records may have been broken, despite the cold, and at times stiff wind!

The Bath volunteers deserve thanks for an excellent job of setting up and doing all the things needed to prepare for and run the field.

Of especial note are Kathy and the Catering Team (who cooked a lot of bacon), the results team who worked hard to collate the results, the field party who set up and cleared away (with a big thank you to the competitors who helped move targets and put away), and everyone else who worked hard make the day the success it was. I must thank our Lord Patron, Stuart Ohren for his challenging mini-competition (worst blue on one end after lunch) and, of course, the competitors for making the day so enjoyable.

Finally, congratulations to our winners and thanks to our competitors - I hope to see you next year.
