

**ARCHERY****Bath archers among winners**

The sun shone as Bath Archers held their Annual Spring Albion Tournament at their shooting ground in Batheaston last Sunday.

An Albion is a 'round' of 9 dozen arrows, 3 dozen at each of 80, 60 and 50 yards, run under the auspices of the UK governing body Archery GB.
