arrow ends.

Competitors must be affiliated to ArcheryGB or BLBS and have their membership cards available for inspection on the

day.

Liability Bath Archers will not be held responsible for injury to any

person, whether competitor or spectator, or for loss or damage to equipment. Entry implies acceptance of these

conditions.

The Field Captain is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times; his/her decision in all matters is final and

must be obeyed.

The organiser has the right to exclude any persons from the

field for unreasonable behaviour.

Photographs Anyone wishing to take photographs/video must complete

the Photograph Log before doing so.

From the South: On the A36 follow the route through Bathampton, over the narrow Canal Bridge and the Toll Bridge over the river Avon (charges apply). Up the hill, turn left at the mini roundabout. The Bath Archers Ground is on the left down the drive to the side of 142 London Road.
